| Sunday, June 02: Piper's opening evening

- Colleville-Montgomery | 5.00 p.m to 11.00 p.m

To open the commemorations of this 80th Anniversary of the Landing and the Battle of Normandy, B.O.W.U International, with the help of the municipality of Colleville-Montgomery, is organising a festive and cultural evening.

Exhibitors around D-Day, restoration and pub, testimonies, aubade of the pipers, parade of period military vehicles...

A free concert by the group Spoon O'Porridge (Celtic folk) will close the evening.

This evening is also a charitable event for the association. All the revenues are a support for the organisation, logistics of ceremonies and the reception of foreign musicians (USA, Canada, British, Australia, Europe...).

June 3, 1944 - June 3, 2024: A forgotten national symbol

The Provisional Government of the French Republic (GPRF) is the name given to the political regime and the corresponding institutions that, succeeding the French Committee for National Liberation (CFLN) on June 3, 1944, ruled for two years the entire territory of metropolitan France and its empire until October 27, 1946.

This tour aims to commemorate the memory of women and men, fighters and civilians, of all nations who lost their lives during the Battle of Normandy.

A parade and a mass band aubade will be organised in each of the three sites, symbolic high places of memory.



| Wednesday, June 05 : The Great Pipers Parade

- Colleville-Montgomery | 3.30 p.m to 5.00 p.m

More than 13 nations of musicians:

Nearly 200 musicians during a great parade on Boulevard Maritime, flying over period PIPER aircraft (British reconnaissance aviation).

A mass band aubade around the Bill Millin statue (the Piper who landed on June 6, 1944 in the same place) will come in the second part, in the presence of the Millin family. An animated memorial film (testimony by Bill Millin) will be broadcast on the big screen in

parallel with the aubade.

At the 75th Anniversary, more than 4,500 spectators were at the rendezvous.



| Thursday, June 06 : D-Day Normandy Cup

- Bénouville | From 10:00 to midnight

To mark the 80th anniversary, the B.O.W.U International association is organising, in partnership with the municipality of Bénouville, an event of cultural, memorial and festive scope, a stone's throw from the mythical Pegasus Bridge.
