

## THE GREAT GATHERING



More than 200 musicians will come together on 5 and 6 June, making our events one of the biggest in France, alongside the Festival Interceltique in Lorient and the Fête Franco-Écossaise in Aubigny-sur-Nère.

The bagpipes have resonated for centuries in Normandy, but they take on a whole new dimension at these ceremonies, through the memory of all the pipers on the front line in the great battles of history, including the Battle of Normandy.

#### **Tribute to Bill Millin**

Once again this year, a tribute will be paid to Piper Bill, during the grand parade of pipers and drummers on the afternoon of 5 June at Place du Débarquement in Colleville-Montgomery, in the presence of the Clan Millin (John and Jacob Millin, sons and grandsons of the famous piper of 6 June 1944).

An animated memorial film is being produced for the event, with the participation of the Millin clan (produced by the company of the association's president).
